Reporting to the AFP Commissioner, the Deputy Commissioner delivers strategies, long-term capability and future direction across the organisation, and is responsible for addressing issues of strategic organisational significance, such as matters with political, safety and reputational impact.

To be a strong contender for appointment, you will possess personal and professional standards, character and values of the highest order, as well as substantial experience in senior police management, law enforcement and contemporary policing. You will be able to demonstrate a history of managing a large organisation and an ability to deal with the challenges of an international and domestic law enforcement environment.

The successful candidate will be able to demonstrate advanced conceptual and analytical skills to provide high-level advice and sustainable solutions to the Commissioner, as well as a strong capacity to build solid relationships and forge strategic partnerships with local and international communities.

You will need to demonstrate outstanding values-based leadership, together with communication, networking, negotiation and change management skills.
