1.	How many Police have received introductory cybercrime investigations training since 2000?	Since commencement, 756 AFP members have completed Cybercrime Tier One, of which 613 were Police members (6 Protective Service Officers (PSO), 134 Unsworn, 3 other).
2.	How many Police have received advanced cybercrime investigations training since 2000?	Since commencement 163 AFP members have completed Cybercrime Tier Two, of which 125 were Police members (1 PSO, 37 Unsworn).
3.	How many Police currently have a full-time role in investigating cybercrime?	As at 13 August 2020, the AFP has 40 Police Officers working full time investigating Cybercrime.
4.	How many sworn Police officers are currently employed by the AFP?	As at 13 August 2020, the AFP has 3285 Police Officers (75 of these are Police Recruits).
