When reporting offences in ACT Policing's case management system case officers have the choice of using generic drop down categories or inputting specific offences from legislation. All offences are mapped to standard statistical categories set out in the Australian National Classification of Offences (ANCO) and Australian Standard Offence Classification (ASOC) created by the Australian Bureau of Statistics. The counting rules below outline which categories we have used to generate the offence counts.

Counting rules:

- Consorting: Number of offences reported under ACT Criminal Code s652 Participating in a Criminal Group.
- Consume/Possess open container of liquor in certain public places: Number of offences reported under ACT Liquor Act s199 Consumer Liquor at certain Public Places or ACT Liquor Act s200 Possess open container of Liquor at certain public places.
- Failure to follow move on direction: Number of offences reported under Crimes Act s179 Fail to comply with exclusion direction (move on direction).
- Fare evasion: Number of offences reported under ASOC 0915 Fare Evasion. This includes taxis.
- Fraud: Number of offences reported under ACT Criminal Code s322 Obtain financial advantage by deception
- Illegal use of motor vehicle: Number of offences reported under ASOC 0812 Illegal Use of a Motor Vehicle.
- Offensive behaviour: Number of offences reported under drop down category 'Offensive Behaviour' or Crimes Act s392 Offensive Behaviour in a Public Place or Intoxicated People Protection Act s4 Intoxicated and Behaving in a Disorderly Manner.
- Shoplifting: Number of offences reported under ANCO 393 Shoplifting.
- Trespass and Vagrancy: Number of offences reported under ANCO 593 Trespass and Vagrancy.
