I'm not aware of any such investigation and subsequent report by Tim Slattery. The best I can put forward was the report by 22 that was included in the material I provided.

When I was the responsible Supt, I did speak with numerous staff about the workplace and any associated wellbeing issues (some members may have interpreted this as an investigation, it wasn't. It was me getting to know the staff and the issues and I did the same in various locations). A summary of what I was advised that went to poor behaviour was also included in the material I provided in the form of an email addressed to Tim Slattery. During this process, at least one matter was referred to PRS/Safe Place. I am not privy to any more detail in relation to their actions or outcomes.
