The Police Overseas Service Medal (POSM) is given to recognize both sworn and unsworn service for designated periods of time. All applicants will be checked for ethical and diligent service during this period. Failure to pass this check will result in the application being declined. Only one clasp can be issued per location. Please return your form to Australian Federal Police, Honours and Awards, PO Box 401 Canberra ACT 2601 or honours-awards@afp.gov.au. All applications are sent for final approval to Government House. New clasps are periodically reviewed.
