| Procurement Description 🔗 | <p>The AFP requires a Solution that will deliver the following capabilities:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. an upgraded platform deployed onto a modern infrastructure platform (on-Premises or SaaS) that provides flexibility to meet the AFP's current and future business requirements for covert data collection; b. ingestion of TI and SD Product from Carriage Service Providers (CSP), technical and electronic surveillance devices, and OSINT; c. improved useability for monitoring, managing, searching, analysis and evidentiary export of TI and SD Product to support investigations; d. an enhanced integration capability (via open Application Programming Interfaces (API)) that allows the AFP to: e. provide a rich suite of APIs to allow the Solution to ingest TI and SD Product and provide TI and SD Product to other AFP-managed systems; f. enable API integration to automate the provisioning of TI and SD Product to internal and external cognitive and AI services; g. allow API integration with the upgraded Electronic Surveillance Warrants and Authorisations Management System (ES-WAMS) to support compliance by reducing manual entry of TI line information and SD warrant provisioning into multiple systems; and h. ingest large volumes of TI and SD Product into the Solution; i. ingestion of historical and stored communications into the Solution to enable visualisation alongside TI and SD Product; j. ingestion and visualisation of tracking Product sourced from geolocation systems; and k. visualise all processed Product via a mobile application. |
